An Invitation to Families and Friends:

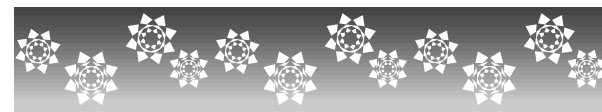
